Commitment to Achieving Net Zero

Bestchoice Global Ltd. is fully committed to achieving Net Zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050 in line with climate change targets and the principles of sustainable healthcare delivery.

We recognise our responsibility as a healthcare and social support provider to reduce the environmental impact of our operations and to actively contribute to a sustainable future for our service users and communities.

Baseline Emissions Footprint

Baseline Year: 2024

This is our first comprehensive organisational emissions assessment. Our baseline figures cover Scope 1, Scope 2, and the mandatory subset of Scope 3 emissions categories as required under PPN 06/21.

Baseline data were estimated using DEFRA conversion factors (2024) and industry benchmarks for small healthcare service providers. Figures will be refined annually as monitoring systems mature.

We have achieved an initial reduction of approximately 10% compared to our 2024 baseline through early energy-saving measures and improved travel management.

Emissions Reduction Targets

Bestchoice Global Ltd aims to reduce emissions by 35% by 2030, with interim milestones as follows:

Target Year	Projected Emissions (tCO ₂ e)	Reduction (%) vs 2024 Baseline
2027	18.0	25%
2030	15.6	35%
2040	8.4	65%
2050	0	100% (Net Zero)

Progress will be reported annually on our website and reviewed at Board level.

Carbon Reduction Projects

Completed Initiatives (2024–2025):

- **Energy Efficiency Improvements:** Transitioned to LED lighting and motion sensors at our Dagenham office, reducing electricity consumption by 15%.
- **Travel Policy Reform:** Introduced virtual meetings and flexible work-from-home arrangements, cutting business travel emissions by approximately 20%.
- **Waste Management:** Implemented recycling stations and reduced paper use by 60% through digital documentation.
- **Supplier Engagement:** Began sourcing environmentally conscious suppliers (e.g., eco-friendly cleaning products, local supply chains).

Planned and Future Initiatives (2025–2030):

- Fleet Electrification: Replace petrol vehicles with electric or hybrid models by 2028.
- Renewable Energy: Install solar panels on office premises by 2027 to offset at least 40% of electricity use.
- Sustainable Procurement Policy: Embed sustainability clauses into supplier contracts, prioritising low-carbon products and local vendors.
- Employee Engagement: Annual training on sustainability awareness and environmental responsibility.
- Carbon Offset Partnerships: Partner with local environmental charities to offset unavoidable emissions through verified tree-planting schemes.

Monitoring and Reporting

- Annual CRP review and update in line carbon reduction standards and PPN 06/21.
- Emissions reporting follows the GHG Protocol Corporate Standard and SECR (Streamlined Energy and Carbon Reporting) framework.
- All data verified internally and signed off by a senior executive.
